What is BusConnects?



BusConnects is a way to make public transport better for everyone in Dublin.



Travel times will be more reliable.

What is BusConnects?



The buses will use 12 new bus corridors.



There will be more cycle lanes.



We will start building the Liffey Valley to City Centre Scheme in Autumn 2025.
